

Book Review presented by Maggie Hankamp

The Genie in Your Genes: Epigenetic Medicine and the New Biology of Intention By Dawson Church
Energy Psychology Press, 2009 Santa Rosa, CA (pbk \$17.95)

What is epigenetics? Epigenetics, per Church, is the study of signals that turn DNA off and on. Internal interventions, such as energy medicine, meditation, prayer, altruism, and external interventions, such as our lifestyle and diet, activate genes. So, eating your broccoli changes human bodies and human body systems as much as changing your attitude. Church's research-backed premise is that our genes do not determinate whether we stay healthy nor whether we get dis-ease. In actuality, we are more in charge than we know. Our expression of a gene is determined both by our physical behaviors, what we eat, drink, and do, as well as by our metaphysical behaviors, what we feel, think, and believe. Church backs up his statement that “...with every feeling and thought, in every instant, you are performing epigenetic engineering on your own cells” with evidence-based research (p.76) Church acknowledges that certain diseases respond best to allopathic treatments, and those treatments are essential for first-line defense. He details other illnesses in which treatment may result in a better outcome if a patient first uses alternatives, such as EFT, reiki (see joke on Pg 335), prayer, yoga, acupuncture, any one of these or a combination of alternatives, before resorting to drugs and surgery. Church maintains, “Energy medicine is not only the place to start treatment of a problem; it is the place to start *before* there is a problem.” How would we feel and work and live and interact if our entire emotional, physical, and mental systems were operating at peak efficiency. I suggest Reiki healers read this book. I personally am re-reading this book to comprehend all of the ramifications of what epigenetics will mean in the future and does mean at present. Chapter 15 is one I keep returning to as a base line for how to integrate epigenetics theory into daily life. This book review presents the views of Maggie Hankamp, and not those views of the SDRC
